Dear Mr. Willumsen,

The Consul-General told me yesterday that you appeared to be under the impression that all the pictures sent in must be for sale. I do not know how you got this idea because my letter of the 18th October is very clear. If you look at the last paragraph, 2nd line, I say 'All the pictures may be for sale' but I do not say they must be. We quite expect that a considerable number of the pictures will be lent by various owners. I put that clause in because in many exhibitions the pictures are not allowed to be sold.
