Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st October addressed to Mr. Roberts, expressing your agreement to the terms of the Corporation exhibitions, sent to you in response to your letter of the 13th October.

On behalf of the Corporation of Brighton I have now to express to you their indebtedness for the hospitality and great kindness shown to Mr. Roberts during his recent visit to Copenhagen. A report containing his impressions of Danish art at the present moment has been presented to the Fine Arts Committee. As a result I have the honour on behalf of the Corporation to invite the Danish artists to send to Brighton a collection of pictures by artists now living, or recently deceased.

I have moreover to thank you personally for undertaking the duties of Chairmanship of the preliminary Committee, which the Corporation hope you will be good enough to continue to fill. As however it is only our intention to exhibit small pieces of sculpture, there will be no need to trouble the two gentlemen representing that branch of art ; but, as we are anxious to have a thoroughly representative exhibition

Each artist can thus have his pictures censored by members representing his own School.

In forwarding you this invitation, I trust you will be good enough to favour me with a reply at your earliest possible convenience, as the question of Royal Patronage, &c. is still in abeyance. The list of the artists taking part may be sent by you later on.
